Service/repair parts washers

- Requires the use of one hand to undo drain plugs and nozzles. Light duty use of the second hand (under 10 pounds) for short duration of time.
- May require use of both hands to stabilize equipment on work bench.
- Involves the use of hand tools for one hand only.

Service/repair misc. shop equipment

- Requires the use of one hand to undo drain plugs. Light duty use of the second hand (under 3 pounds) for short duration of time for pouring oil.
- May require use of both hands to stabilize equipment on work bench.
- Involves the use of hand tools for one hand only.

Organize stock room

- Requires the occasional use of both hands but limited to lifting weights less than 10 pounds with the injured hand.
- Correct marking and labelling of parts boxes.
- Identifying stock shortage while organizing.

General check over/repairs to summer equipment

- General check over of summer equipment, rotate between a visual inspection and hands on repair, limiting the use of the right hand to not lifting more than 10 pounds and no repetitious movement.

Clean and service power Hacksaw

- Change blade and clean the metal shavings
- Identifying and listing major repairs that need to be completed.

Check and replenish shop supplies

- Restock the day to day supplies that are depleted in the shop and the Westside compound.

Service/repair sand blaster cabinet

- Drain, clean and repair of this equipment will require light duty service, however the heavy lifting of refill sand will require assistance.

Service Mig Welder

- Check liner and spool, lubricate rollers

Clean Tool crib

- Organize hand tools to proper location identify if racks need to be built.
